CSUR OUTREACH UPDATE REPORT Q2 2019

CSUR Outreach was busy in Q2 2019 in both presentations and planning.

During the last week of May, CSUR was a key participant in the second CREATE ReDeveLoP (Responsible Development of Low-Permeability hydrocarbon resources) Challenge Annual Conference, held in Calgary. At this year's conference, CSUR President Dan Allan and Director Brad Hayes presented on "Science and Public Perception", and on "Listening to Advocates", while other CSUR Board members were active as judges and panelists.

In June, CSUR was invited by our partners at Synergy Alberta to present on water resources and hydraulic fracturing at town hall meetings in Sylvan Lake and Gull Lake. More than 100 community members attended these two meetings, where AER and Alberta Environment also presented, and CSUR member Repsol Energy and other industry operators were represented.

Near the end of June, we presented our foundational "Changing the Game" talk to about 60 summer students and young professionals working for member Crescent Point Energy. This meeting was a great educational experience for the employees, and a much-appreciated service for Crescent Point.

As we move through the summer, we are planning another student / young professional meeting, to be presented by Chad Lemke of GLJ. We will also undertake detailed planning for a busy fall Outreach schedule, which will address more diverse university and professionals groups across the country.
