PRESENTATION: Comparison overview between US plays and the Montney

North America is home to prolific unconventional plays but not all are created equal. Development of unconventional plays is driving production growth in both Canada and the US. At the same time, investor focus has shifted away from pure growth metrics towards return on capital and profitability metrics. In this presentation we will use Wood Mackenzie's granular play and company models to assess how profitable these investment decisions are today and where economic shifts are occurring the fastest. Key trends that will be analyzed across these plays include productivity, capital allocation, production and economic factors including commodity prices.
